On Feb. 7, 2025, in , Batavia, Ill. ALDI, the fastest-growing grocer in the U.S., announced in a Public Release to Newswire that it plans to open more than 225 new store locations in 2025. Through acquisitions of rivals' stores the company plans to continue selling its minimalist and low-cost approach to retail customers all over the US.
