- discuss how the UAPs can inform Jesuit university responses to Covid-19
- explore connections between the individual UAPs
- present how specific Jesuit universities are implementing the UAPs
- provide resources for faculty across disciplines for integrating the UAPs into teaching and research
- highlight the contributions of Jesuit higher education to the UAPs across the works of the Society
- explore collaborations between Jesuit higher education and other Jesuit apostolates, including social ministries
- engage the UAPs as the orientation for and horizon of Jesuit higher education;
- contextualize the process for the development and promotion of the UAPs
- explore the UAPs in the current context of Jesuit and Catholic higher education
- develop shared language and concepts to make explicit the implicit mission-centered work already underway at Jesuit universities
