The **Journal of Management for Global Sustainability (JMGS)**, the official peer-reviewed journal of IAJBS, welcomes submissions from all management disciplines (e.g. international business, accounting, marketing, finance, operations) and from related disciplines (e.g. economics, political science), especially manuscripts that show how we can “contribute more effectively in moving toward a more sustainable world” (Stoner, 2013*) in the spirit of Laudato Si’..

JMGS has recently been included in the Cabell’s Journalytics database.

Articles shall be subject to a double-blind review process overseen by an international editorial board. Submissions of theoretical work, empirical studies, book reviews, pedagogical tools and practitioner manuscripts are all encouraged.
